New Chief UFC Calendar and Notice Of Court Date

Effective immediately, King County Superior Court announces a new form called the "Notice of Court Date – Chief UFC Judge". This form replaces the Family Law "Notice of Court Date – Default" form and should be used ONLY to set the following types of hearings in front of the Chief UFC Judge:

- Weapons Surrender Motions or Hearings (Wednesday at 8:30 am)
- Invalidity Final Orders (Friday 8:30 am)
- Motions for Default when there has been an appearance (Friday 1:30 pm)
- All other motions/matters heard by the Chief UFC Judge (You must obtain a date from the Chief UFC Bailiff before filing this Notice)

For cases without an assigned judge (Monday-Friday):

- Motions without Oral Argument
- Reconsideration of Chief UFC Orders
- Motions for revision (Your date may be changed based on judicial availability)
