## Proposed Local Rule Changes Published for Comment

### Comment Period Open March 1 – April 30, 2021

King County Superior Court is publishing several proposed rule changes for review and comment. Pursuant to King County Local Civil Rule 83, the review and comment period for the proposed new rules and amendments is now open and the Court will consider all comments received prior to May 1, 2021.
