2023 Public Defenders' Certification Repository Number Announcement

For 2023, the "case" number in which to file Certification of Compliance with applicable standards is 23-0-12055-1.

Pursuant to the Standards for Indigent Defense, adopted by the Washington Supreme Court in 2012, these certifications are required for public defenders practicing in certain case types.

In King County, attorneys are required to e-file the certificates. The Supreme Court certification form is available as an e-form in the Clerk's eFiling application with the appropriate case number already inserted. Per the standard, attorneys are to submit one certificate per quarter.

Instructions: Access the Clerk's eFiling application via the following web page: (<http://www.kingcounty.gov/courts/clerk/documents/efiling.aspx>). Log in, then select the "Use e-Form Template" link. Enter the case number and select the "Certification of Defense Counsel" New Form/Order Template. Finally, complete the template by entering your information via the Data Entry tab, save the document and complete the e-filing process.
