## Summary

*NOTE: Covid-19 pandemic affects the statistics, as of March 2020*

- **Filings**

**2021 annual filings.** The filings in 2021 were: 394 dependency cases, 203 termination cases, 65 at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, 61 truancy cases, and 155 others <sup>(1)</sup>.

**2022 annual filings.** The filings in 2022 were: 385 dependency cases, 188 termination cases, 100 at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, 1061 truancy cases, and 193 others.

**2023 filings.** The YTD filings in 2023 were: 186 dependency cases, 95 termination cases, 65 at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, 1,092 truancy cases, and 167 others.

- **Resolutions (approval or dismissal of petitions)**

*Resolution is defined as either the “approval” or the “dismissal” of the petition.*

**2021 annual resolutions.** The resolutions in 2021 were: 399 dependency cases, 265 termination cases, 55 at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, 587 truancy cases, and 170 others <sup>(1)</sup>.

**2022 annual resolutions.** The resolutions in 2022 were: 324 dependency cases, 165 termination cases, 86 at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, 429 truancy cases, and 155 others.

**2023 resolutions.** The YTD resolutions in 2023 were: 163 dependency cases, 119 termination cases, 58 at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, 347 truancy cases, and 162 others.

- **Pending Resolution**

At the end of June 2023, the pending resolution (petitions are neither approved nor dismissed yet) caseload was: 240 dependency cases, 180 termination cases, 47 at-risk-youth and child-in-need of service cases, 1,739 truancy cases, and 82 others.

- **Age of Pending Resolution Cases**

At the end of June 2023, there were a number of cases (older than 180 days since filing) which remained as unresolved (still pending the approval or dismissal of the petitions): 107 dependency cases, 106 termination cases, 18 at-risk-youth and child-in-need of service cases, and 671 truancy cases.

- **Number of Fact-findings (FF)**

**2021 annual fact-findings.** The number of fact-findings in 2021 were: 193 for dependency cases, 197 for termination cases, 19 for at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, and 86 for others.

**2022 annual fact-findings.** The number of fact-findings in 2022 were: 211 for dependency cases, 131 for termination cases, 48 for at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, 6 for truancy cases, and 140 for others.

**2023 fact-findings.** The YTD number of fact-findings in 2023 were: 108 for dependency cases, 76 for termination cases, 28 for at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, 27 for truancy cases, and 123 for others.

- **Number of Hearings (non Fact-findings)**

**2021 annual hearings.** The number of non fact-finding hearings in 2021 were: 7,066 for dependency cases, 448 for termination cases, 77 for at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, and 388 for others.

**2022 annual hearings.** The number of non fact-finding hearings in 2022 were: 7,467 for dependency cases, 439 for termination cases, 166 for at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, 54 for truancy cases, and 781 for others.

**2023 hearings.** The YTD number of non fact-finding hearings in 2023 were: 4,135 for dependency cases, 420 for termination cases, 77 for at-risk-youth and children-in-need of service cases, 194 for truancy cases, and 413 for others.

*(1) “Others” category includes the following case types: DDP - Developmental Disability; DGN - Dependency Guardianship; RVS - Relative Visitation; EFC - Extended Foster Care, Dependency; GFC - Guardianship Foster Children; RPR - Reinstatement of Parental rights; and VYG - Vulnerable Youth Guardianship.*

## Terminology

### **Filings**

Number of petitions (cases) filed.

### **Resolutions**

Number of petitions (cases) resolved, either by “approval” or “dismissal” of petitions. Unlike the definition of “resolution” for other Superior Court case types, the “resolution” for these case categories does not indicate the end of judicial involvement if the petition is approved.

### **Pending Resolution**

Number of active cases that have not been resolved, namely the petition has neither been approved nor dismissed yet.

### **Resolved, Pending Completion**

Number of cases for which the petition has been approved, but issues (sometime significant issues) still remain in which the court is actively involved.

### **Resolution Age**

Time (days) from filing to resolution, less suspense time if applicable.

### **Pending Resolution Case Age**

Time (days) from filing to the last day of the reporting period for these cases that still remain unresolved (no approval or dismiss yet), less suspense time, if applicable.

### **Pending Completion Case Age since the Approval of Petition**

Time (days) from filing from the approval of the original petition (resolution) to the last day of the reporting period for those cases that still remain uncompleted (resolved, but with court activities), less suspense time, if applicable.

### **Number of Fact-findings (FF)**

This is an estimate of actual fact-finding hearings held due to siblings belonging to one family unit having data entered on each case for the same fact-finding hearing proceeding.

### **Number of Hearings (non Fact-findings)**

Number of all hearings other than fact-findings entered during the reporting period. The number of hearings is further divided into “pre-resolution” and “post-resolution” hearings depending on the time of the hearings in relation to the resolution date.
