VIRTUAL AND IN-PERSON MEETING

1. Welcome

2. Discussion of PDAB's Annual Budget Report

Shoshana shares a draft of the budget report with the board. She briefly explains the contents, noting that it's focused largely on the need to enhance the department's ability to provide clients with the support of mitigation specialists by including the job class in DPD's staffing model. General discussion follows, with several board members noting the importance of such services to DPD's clients.

Lou moves to approve the draft report, noting that it will need to be shared with the relevant parties, including the labor unions and DPD leadership, before final approval.

John seconds.

Motion approved.

In other business, Angélica notes ongoing concern about the dire conditions in the King County Jail and whether PDAB should weigh in on this issue. Board members will review materials they've already received about this issue and consider holding another focused, special meeting to decide next steps.
