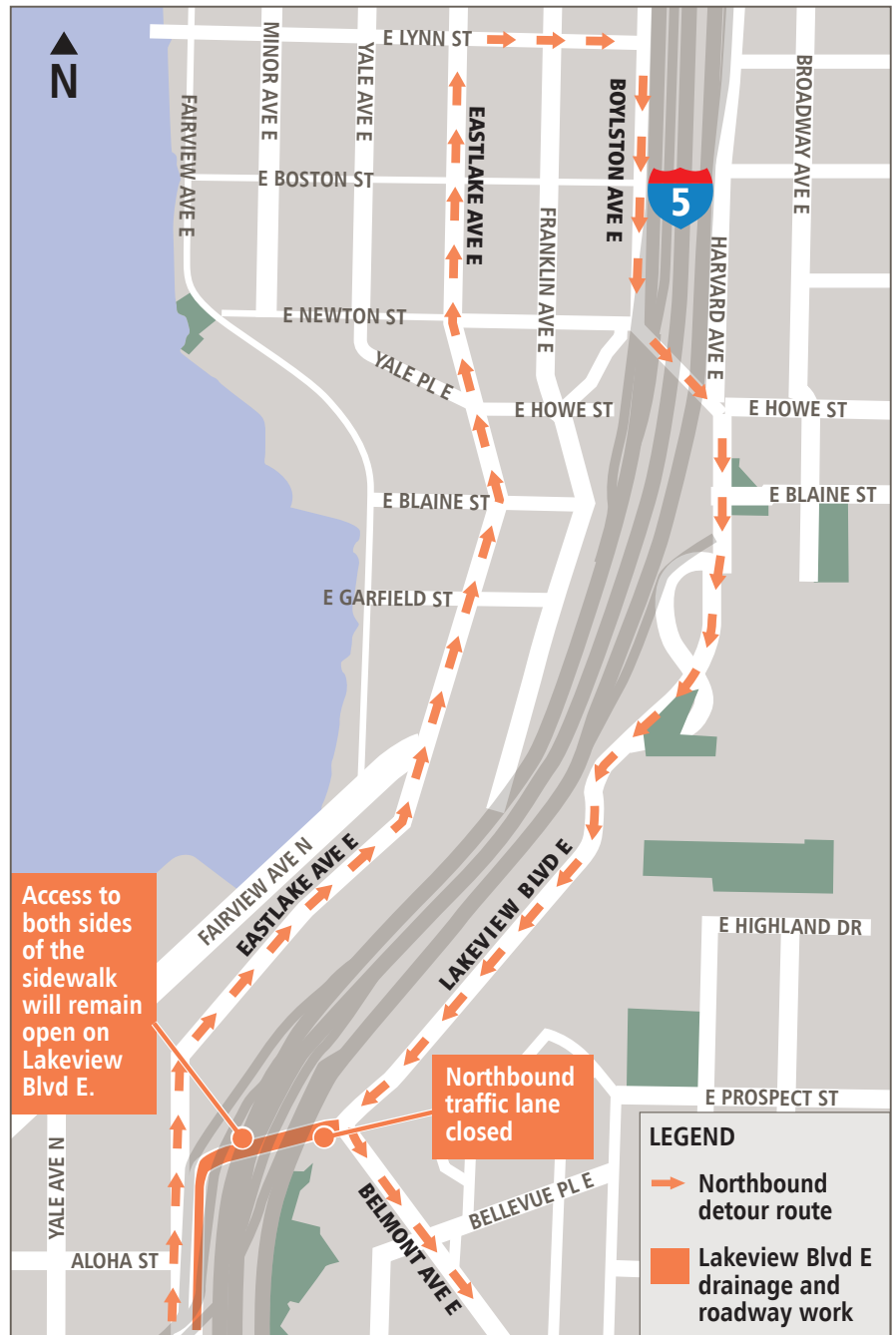
Notice of upcoming construction

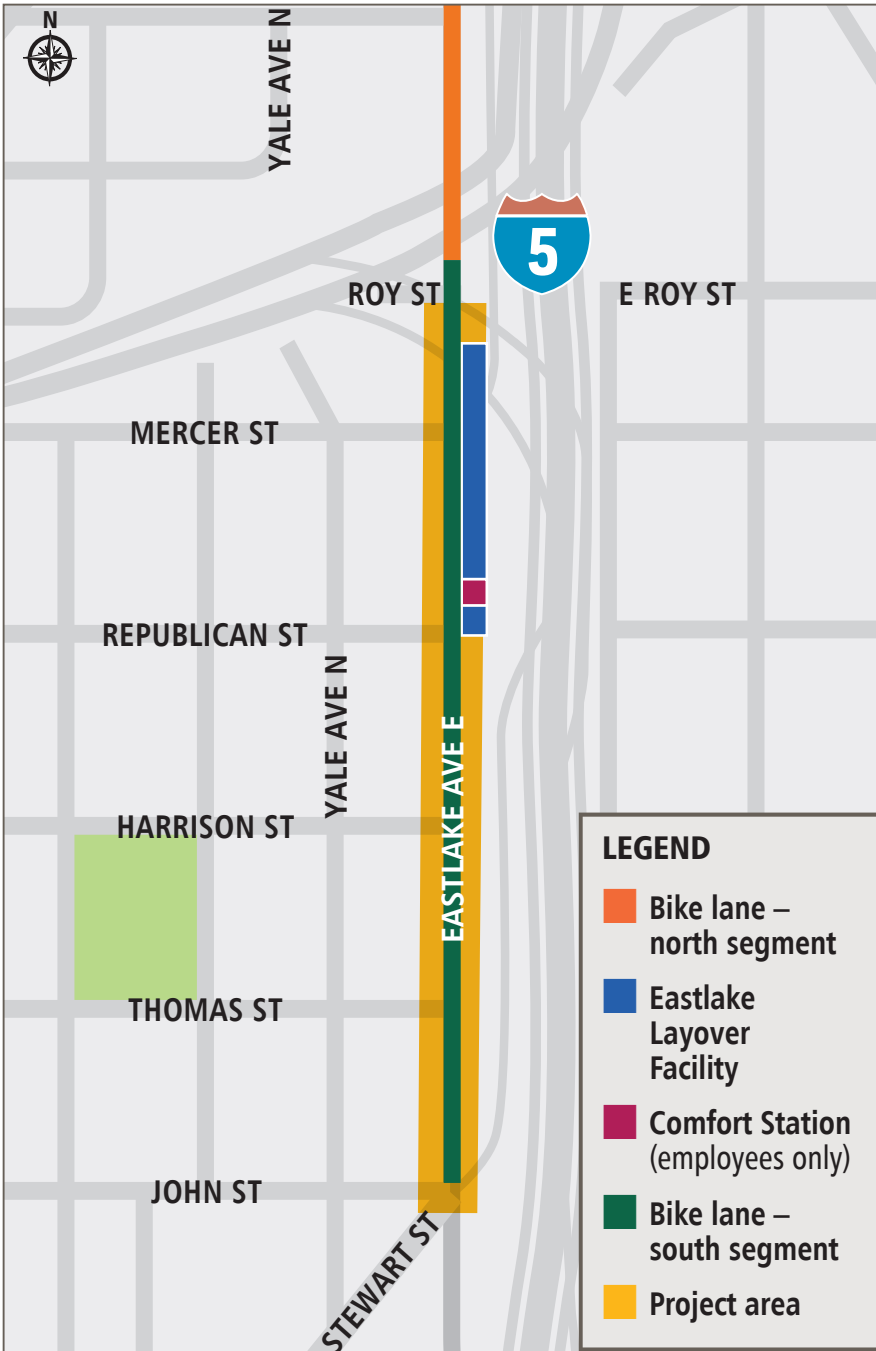
Scheduled to start Sunday, October 15, crews will set up traffic control to begin roadway demolition and pour concrete to restore the southbound traffic lane of Lakeview Boulevard East. During this work, southbound traffic will be temporarily shifted, and a detour will be in place for northbound traffic. The southbound roadway panels will need to cure (dry) for 15 days before crews can switch to pouring the northbound roadway panels and allow for the same curing (drying) duration. This work is anticipated to continue throughout fall 2023 and is weather dependent which may result in delays.

During this work:

- ▶ Lakeview Boulevard will be closed to northbound traffic. Southbound traffic will remain open.
- ▶ A detour route will be in place for people driving northbound. See the map for details.
- ▶ Access for people walking and rolling will be maintained on the west side of Lakeview Boulevard.
- ▶ Access to the northbound and southbound bike lanes will be maintained. People using the northbound bike lane will be provided with a path through the construction zone and then continue on to the existing bike lane. People using the southbound bike lane will shift to the southbound travel lane when traveling through the construction zone.
- ▶ Access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained.





What to expect

Construction on the Eastlake Layover Facility will continue until summer 2024. Typical work hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Some nighttime and weekend work may be required. You can expect:

- ▶ Temporary parking restrictions
- ▶ Periodic lane closures
- ▶ Flaggers to direct traffic around the work areas
- ▶ Detours for people walking, rolling, and biking
- ▶ Construction staging and parking impacts near the construction site
- ▶ Some sidewalk, intersection and lane closures
- ▶ Typical construction impacts, such as noise, truck activity and dust and debris

Project background

To keep everyone safe on the streets in this location, King County Metro is building a facility on the east side of Eastlake Avenue East, next to Interstate 5 between Roy and Republican streets. When built, the facility will accommodate 11 bus layover spaces and provide a place for bus operators to take breaks and access safe restroom facilities. This is an increasingly busy corridor, where people driving vehicles, walking, or rolling intermix with buses on layover.
