The King County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has received and reviewed the investigative materials from the Seattle Police Department and King County Department of Adult and Juvenile Detention, concerning the in-custody death of Dustin Soderlund-Wysong at the King County Correctional Facility on February 25, 2018.

After a careful review of these materials, we are satisfied that the investigation is now complete. Pursuant to Executive Order PHL-7-1-5-EO, we do not recommend an inquest be initiated because the role of law enforcement was *de minimis* and did not contribute in any discernable way to Mr. Soderlund-Wysong's death.
